	Week 4	WHOLE-CLASS LESSONS: Continue to provide reading content instruction. Introduce transitioning from Classroom Library Station AND the Fluency Station.	<b>LITERACY STATION TIME:</b> Students maintain their stamina transitioning between Classroom Library Static AND the Fluency Station.

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
