













apostrophe	A punctuation mark typically used to show possession or contractions	
author's purpose	Reason for the book/story; persuade, inform, entertain	
beginning consonant	first sound in a word that is not a vowel	

chapter	A main division of a book	
complete sentence	Having all of the necessary parts - capital letter, punctuation, make sense	The cat climbed up the tree.
consonant blend	Two to three consonants smoothly joined together	
ending consonant	The last sound in a word that is not a vowel	Cat
final -e	The e at the end of the word makes the vowel say its name	cake
future tense	An action or state in time yet to come	
main character	person, animal, or figure in a literary work	
middle vowel sound	The short vowel sound in between two consonants	cat
moral	Lesson from the story	

past tense	A form of a verb that shows something that happened before or in the past	
Photograph	A picture made by a camera;	
plural	More than one	
poetry	Literary work in which the expression of feelings and ideas is given intensity by distinctive style and rhythm	
present tense	A form of a verb that shows something that is happening now
