



# Describe a symptom of binge-watching.

## EXTRA EVIDENCE WITH ELABORATION

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Inference

When an individual stops interacting with people in the real world, he is likely binge watching.

Evidence

Source 1 states the viewer was “supposed to be spending time with (her) family.”

Elaboration

This is important because it reveals she prioritized the characters in the fictional world over those in her actual world.

Evidence

Source 3 depicts the viewer using a laptop and Source 1 states she was “crouching over” her laptop.

Elaboration

Because laptops are usually used by individuals, this likely means each was alone— or even hiding from other people— while watching a show.

Evidence

Source 2 reveals personal items on the wall and shelves in the background.

Elaboration

This implies he is in his own bedroom.

Elaboration

This further illustrates that the individual is not in a public space of the house.

Conclusion

When someone stops interacting with people and isolates himself, he is guilty of binge watching.
