Inference

When an individual stops interacting with people in the real world, he is likely binge watching.



Source 1 states the viewer was "supposed to be spending time with (her) family."

This is important because it reveals she prioritized the characters in the fictional world over those in her actual world.



Source 3 depicts the viewer using a laptop and Source 1 states she was "crouching over" her laptop.

Because laptops are usually used by individuals, this likely means each was alone— or even hiding from other people— while watching a show.



Source 2 reveals personal items on the wall and shelves in the background.

This implies he is in his own bedroom.

This further illustrates that the individual is not in a public space of the house.



When someone stops interacting with people and isolates himself, he is guilty of binge watching.
