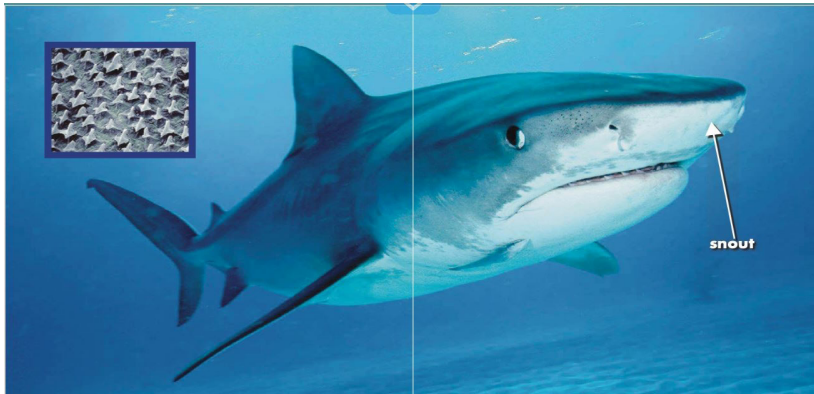


Retell requires a 2-step process.

**STEP 1 | Reading Voice collects details.**

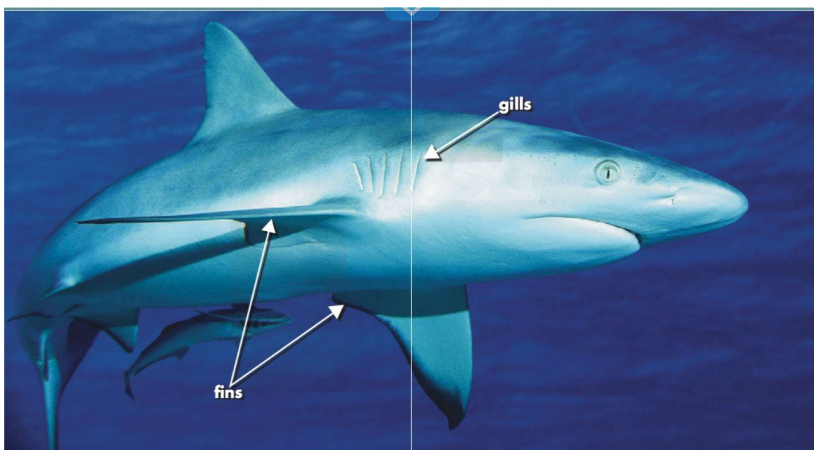
**STEP 2 | Thinking Voice adds a label.**

Sharks have **fins**. They use their fins to turn and stop in the water.
