
Build Anchor-Chart Boards with Velcro Pieces

STEP 1 | Print the pieces.

• Change the scaling to 70%.

Purchase Corrugated

Purchase **Velcro Circles Sticky Back** 500 Pack — 3/4"



Purchase Acrylic Floating Shelves — 4 Pack.



Purchase **Force Magnets**— 10 Pack.




STEP 7 | **Adhere** the Velcro sticky dots.


- Remove a pair of Velcro dots from the package.
- Put the two sides together.
- Stick the "soft" side of the Velcro onto the laminated piece. (The sticky back of the "rough" Velcro will be exposed.)
- Press it in position firmly onto the board.
- Repeat this process for all pieces.

STEP 8 | **Store** laminated pieces.

- Turn the board over.
- Put four more paired Velcro circles on the corners of a gallon-sized baggie.
- Push firmly onto the backside of the board.
- Insert the photograph of the completed anchor chart and any loose pieces.

STEP 3 | Lay out each piece onto the board.

• Print in color and onto card stock.

• Follow the photograph of the completed chart.

STEP 2 | Trim each piece closely. (Titles and larger

graphics will print onto multiple pages. They need

to be trimmed, overlapped, and taped together.)

• Additional trimming may be required to ensure all pieces fit.

STEP 4 | Laminate each piece.

STEP 5 | **Trim** off the excess lamination from each piece.

STEP 6 | **Lay out** each **laminated** piece onto the board.

 When adding the Velcro is Step 7, you will remove one anchor chart piece at a time from its position to maintain accurate spacing and layout.
