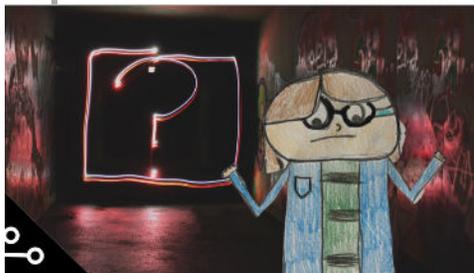


Simulation 2 (Handwriting)

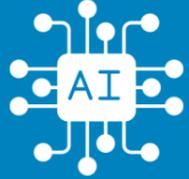


My Story
